

NAMEPLATES

The Norco Conservation Camp manufactures CAL FIRE nameplates at the request of the administrative unit and they are available from the camp via an MRT. There are three CAL FIRE nameplates authorized for use by employees as follows:

Dress Uniform Nameplate

Standard Nameplate

Nameplate for Use with Civilian Clothes

The **Dress Uniform** nameplate is authorized for wear on the Dress Uniform coat only. The color of the nameplate will be gold for Chief Officers and silver for Non-Chief Officers. The nameplate size is five-eighths inch by two and one-half inches. The first name or initial and the last name of the employee will be engraved on the nameplate in black letters. Nothing else will appear on the nameplate.

The **Standard CAL FIRE** nameplate has the employee's name and unit of assignment. Standard nameplate size will be seven-eighths of an inch by three and one-quarter inches or long enough to allow the name and unit to be engraved legibly. This nameplate will be worn on all uniforms, as specified, except the dress uniform coat.

The **Civilian Clothes** nameplate will be three inches by two and one-half inches long in front. The back flap is three inches long. All permanent uniformed employees are authorized three standard nameplates for wear with jackets and shirts. All permanent uniformed employees who are required to have a dress uniform are authorized two dress uniform nameplates. One nameplate for use with civilian clothes may be allowed for uniformed and non-uniformed employees, if appropriate for the assignment.

Sacramento Headquarters Business Services Office will only pay for two standard nameplates for each new employee. The employee's unit will pay for all other nameplates.
