

## **ROOFING OPERATIONS**

(November 1991)

When doing a roofing operation on a roof less than 20 feet above ground level, the only precaution necessary is good safety planning, which includes a project safety work plan and tailgate sessions.

When doing a roofing operation on a roof more than 20 feet above the ground, employees must be protected from falling off the roof by one of the following methods:

- A parapet at least 24 inches high.
- Safety belts and lines.
- Catch platforms.
- Scaffold platforms.
- Eave barriers.
- Roof jack systems. (Safety lines are required in conjunction with roof jack systems on roofs steeper than 7:12.)

When using hot asphalt, take extreme caution to protect employees. See CCR, Title 8, Construction Safety Orders, Article 30, for additional information.
