

ABANDONMENT AND DESTRUCTION

GSA or the US Forest Service may recommend disposal of property by abandonment and destruction (normally this requires delivering the item to the nearest landfill). GSA makes this recommendation if, after offering the property for transfer, donation and sale, it determines the property has no commercial value and is useless. The Forest Service PMO may recommend abandonment and destruction for items that are not feasible to scrap or sale. Sometimes approval is given when property is at a location that is not cost effective to sale. Complete the Abandonment and Destruction on an AD-112 and forward to the Sacramento FEPP office for approval by USFS. Once approved complete the AD-112 by signing the document; this signifies that the process was completed. Then send a copy of the signed AD-112 to the Sacramento FEPP office. The Sacramento office will forward the information to the USFS which will remove the item from record. All such property must have all identification markings removed. Do not abandon or destroy property in a manner that is detrimental or dangerous to public health or safety.
