A wide variety of technical services are performed as part of CDF's daily operations, enabling the department to perform its missions.

The Technical Services section in Sacramento has functional responsibility for the department's lands and improvements. These responsibilities include the following activities:

- Planning
- Budgeting
- Designing
- Construction
- Maintenance
- Operation
- Energy Management
- Land Acquisition
- Land Management
- Environmental Documentation

The engineering and construction staffs in the Regions provide technical support for these activities. This technical support includes the responsibility for the problem definition and proposal statements in Capital Outlay Budget Change Proposals (COBCP's) for both major and minor capital outlay projects, the construction of minor capital outlay projects and the implementation of special repair projects.

The authority for many of these technical services projects is derived from the requirements of the Public Contracts Code, and the Business and Professional Code regarding proper professional licensing and the need for significant levels of technical knowledge as established by the State Personnel Board for various technical classes.
