If Workers' Compensation benefits become an issue, the claim shall be referred to the Inmate/Ward Workers' Compensation Council for case responsibility determination.
3. The Youth Authority will provide medical care as needed. If Workers' Compensation benefits become an issue, the claim will be referred to the Inmate/Ward Workers' Compensation Council for case responsibility determination.

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
