Individual rate per hour: \$1.00

Camp Correctional Officers and staff other than inmates and wards:

The Camp Crew in-kind grant matching rates for FY2010-11 are:

Average crew cost per hour: \$ 222.47
Average crew cost per 8 hour day: \$1,779.75

California Conservation Corps: Corps members , specialists, Leaders and Resource
Trainees:

Rates are determined by the California Conservation Corps.
