Required and recommended training for CAL FIRE personnel is listed in the Employee Training Program Guides. The training guides provide course information on specific training for CAL FIRE personnel. This information includes course duration, responsibility for providing, timing, whether the training is mandatory, policy, or optional; any provisions for recertification, training prerequisites and other information on the course for both the employee and the supervisor based on the requirements of each classification. Specific course information referenced can be found in Section 4021, Training Courses. Incident Command System classification courses are not included as part of the Employee Training Program Guides, as individual attendance is based on specific needs of the department and the unit.

New departmental employees will not be allowed to participate in any fire suppression or other emergency activity until they have successfully met the safety training requirements listed in the appropriate Employee Training Program Guide(s), or equivalent if approved by the Director, for their respective civil service classification.
