PURPOSE

In an effort to thwart the increasing threat of counterfeit training certificates, the Department has instituted measures designed to make certificate authentication easier. Using a consistent size, overall design, appropriate level signatures, CAL FIRE logo, and State Seal watermark should make a non-standard certificate much easier to recognize and therefore question.

USAGE

The new Standard CAL FIRE Training Certificate will be used for all CAL FIRE certificated training sponsored by the Academy or Regions. As an extra security measure, embossing machines with the appropriate seal will also be used. The embossing seal shall be affixed over the Chief's signature. Other training facilities (training centers, camps, units, etc.) are authorized to use the same form, however without the embossing seal.

CAL FIRE Training Certificates are authorized for use of Apprenticeship journey level Firefighter II, Fire Apparatus Engineer (FAE), and Heavy Equipment Operators (HFEO). The Journey Equivalency Certificate will be the same CAL FIRE Training Certificate form, with the embossing seal. Non-apprentices who have an individual training plan reviewed and approved by SubJAC and who have completed the required training and successfully passed the written and performance exams are eligible for a CAL FIRE journey level certificate. Prior to issuing a journey Equivalency Certificate. The CAL FIRE SubJAC Committee must approve the request for the Journey Equivalency Certificate. Upon Approval, the request will be forwarded to the CAL FIRE Academy Administrator for processing.
