

## FIRE PROTECTION TRAINING GUIDE - FIRE APPARATUS ENGINEER (PARAMEDIC)

(No. 8 May 1999)

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Possession of a valid driver license of the appropriate class issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles. Applicants who do not possess the license will be admitted to the examination but must secure the license prior to appointment.

and

Possession of a current Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic (EMT- P) certificate issued by a California County Health Officer;

or

enrollment in an approved paramedic training program within five months of completion. (Proof of paramedic certification applicable to county of employment will be required prior to appointment.)

and

Experience: Either

1. Eight months of fire-fighting experience.

Or

2. Enrollment in the California Fire Fighter Joint Apprenticeship Committee Pre-apprenticeship Outreach Program. and Eight months of fire-fighting experience.

Or

3. Two years of experience as a certified volunteer fire fighter.

Or

4. Two years of experience as a Fire Prevention Specialist II

and

successful completion of the mandatory training courses prescribed for a Department of Forestry and Fire Protection Fire Fighter I. (Candidates who are within two months of satisfying the experience requirement under Pattern I above for this class will be admitted to the examination, but they must fully meet the experience requirement before being eligible for appointment.)
