ORIENTATION TO WATER
AND HOSE USE

TOPIC: HOW TO MAKE AN OUT-OF-SERVICE HOSE ROLL - ONE PERSON METHOD

TIME FRAME: 0:15

LEVEL OF INSTRUCTION: Level II

BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE:

Condition: Given one length of 1 ½" or 1 ¾" unrolled hose with male and female couplings

Behavior: The student will roll hose using the one person out-of-service hose roll method

Standard: With a minimum of 70% accuracy, within 2 minutes, according to the job breakdown

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Job breakdown
- One length of hose per student
- One set full wildland PPE per student
- One stop watch

PREPARATION:

When hose becomes damaged at the scene of a fire, on a drill or when testing, it becomes necessary to identify it as out-of-service. Damaged hose rolled in an out-of-service hose roll can be quickly identified and separated from serviceable hose.

HOW TO MAKE AN OUT-
OF-SERVICE HOSE ROLL -
ONE PERSON

OPERATIONS	KEY POINTS
1. Lay out hose	1a. Straight
	b. Flat
	c. No kinks and twists
	d. Fully extended
2. Take position	2a. At female coupling
	b. Facing male coupling
3. Lean forward or squat	3a. Bending at waist/knees
4. Grasp coupling	4a. Female
	b. With both hands
5. Roll Coupling	5a. Forward over hose
	b. Forming core
	c. Leaving hand hold space
6. Roll hose	6a. Toward male coupling
	b. Keeping rolled edge even
	c. Tightly
	d. Until male coupling is reached
	e. Do not roll over male coupling
7. Lay rolled hose down	7a. Carefully
	b. On its side
	c. Flatten out roll
8. Secure or store rolled hose	8a. With rubber band or restraining device
	b. In proper compartment
	c. In designated out- of-service area

Performance Examination

HOW TO MAKE AN OUT-OF-SERVICE HOSE ROLL – ONE PERSON METHOD

APPLICATION:

The student will practice making an out-of-service hose roll using the one person method, under Fire Captain/instructor supervision.

EVALUATION:

The student will complete a manipulative performance test at a time determined by the instructor.

Practice making the out-of-service hose roll using the one person method, in preparation for the upcoming performance test.
