FIREFIGHTER SAFETY

TOPIC/EQUIPMENT: Use The One-Piece - Roll Down Fire Resistive Curtain

CATEGORY: Performance Exam

POINTS POSSIBLE: 100

TIME ALLOWED: 20 Seconds

BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE:

Condition: A CAL FIRE Model 9 fire engine with one piece - roll down fire resistive curtain

Behavior: The student will deploy the one piece roll down fire resistive curtain under simulated fire conditions, while wearing full wildland fire personal protective equipment and seat belt

Standard: With a minimum 80% accuracy, within 20 seconds, according to the score sheet

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- One (1) CAL FIRE Model 9 fire engine with one piece - roll down fire resistive curtain
- One (1) set of wildland fire personal protective equipment per student
- One (1) stop watch
- One (1) score sheet per student
- One (1) manipulative performance test cover page
- One (1) clip board
- Two (2) red pens

FIREFIGHTER SAFETY

PROCEDURES:

The examination and time will start when the student either verbally or by conduct performs any step of the performance examination.

SCORING:

Points will be deducted for each step omitted, performed improperly, or performed out of sequence. Steps designated by an asterisk (*) must be performed properly or the student fails the entire examination. If the student goes over the allotted time he/she will fail the entire test.

SPECIAL NOTES:

Before the examination begins the student will be allowed to ask any clarifying questions and inspect the equipment. The student will be seated in the crew compartment seat, wearing full wildland fire personal protective equipment and seatbelt.

Once the examination begins, the exam proctor shall not answer any questions or intercede in any way, unless safety violations occur that would injure personnel or damage equipment.
