HOSE

TOPIC: How to Carry Hose From A Hose Bed - One Shoulder Carry Method

TIME FRAME: :15

LEVEL OF INSTRUCTION: II

BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE:

Condition: An engine with suitable hose bed, 2 lengths of 2- 1/2" hose, with an attached nozzle

Behavior: The student will demonstrate the proper method of performing a working 2-1/2" hose line carry using the one shoulder carry method under simulated fire conditions

Standard: With a minimum of 80% accuracy within one minute

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- An engine with a suitable hose bed
- Two sections of 2-1/2" hose with an attached nozzle
- Performance examinations
- Individual score sheets
- One (1) stop watch
- One (1) clip board
- One (1) red pen
- Appropriate fire safety PPE per CAL FIRE policy

OPERATIONS

KEY POINTS

- | OPERATIONS | KEY POINTS |
|---|---|
| 1. Take position | 1a. Near hose bed
b. On ground
c. Facing hose bed |
| 2. Grasp nozzle or coupling | 2a. Coupling or nozzle against front of body
b. Coupling or nozzle pointing downward
c. At chest height |
| 3. Feed hose over shoulder | 3a. Hose flat
b. Hand over hand
c. Down back
d. To knee height |
| 4. Loop hose back over shoulder | 4a. Flat
b. Upon itself
c. With fold in front at waist |
| 5. Continue looping hose back over shoulder | 5a. Alternating loops front and rear
b. Until section of hose is loaded |
| 6. Uncouple hose | 6a. Leave coupling in hose bed |
| 7. Grasp coupling | 7a. Front of body
b. At chest height |
| 8. Attach coupling use adaptor if necessary | 8a. To engine discharge
b. Hand tight |
| 9. Turn | 9a. In direction of travel |
| 10. Proceed to destination | 10a. Hose should pay off top as it becomes taut
b. Avoid obstructions
c. Fully extended |
