TOPIC/EQUIPMENT: Using Chock Blocks and Seat Belts

CATEGORY: Performance Examination

POINTS POSSIBLE: 100

TIME ALLOWED: 3 minutes

BEHAVIORAL OBJECTIVE:

Condition: Given a CAL FIRE engine parked on level ground and student wearing all required personal protective safety ensemble (PPE).

Behavior: The student, standing next to the engine, upon command will board the engine, fasten the seat belt, fasten the safety chain (if so equipped) and then dismount the engine and set chock blocks for level ground, upslope and down slope engine attitude under simulated fire conditions

Standard: With a minimum of 80% accuracy, within three (3) minutes according to the score sheet

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- One (1) CAL FIRE engine with chock blocks, seat belts and roll bar
- One (1) Manipulative Performance Test Cover Page
- One (1) Score Sheet Per Student
- One (1) clip board
- One (1) stopwatch
- One (1) red pen
- One (1) set of wildland fire Personal Protective Equipment per student per CAL FIRE Policy

2. Student fastens seat belt, shoulder harness (if equipped)	*

6. Student removes chock blocks form holders or compartments	5
