



LOOK UP, LOOK DOWN, LOOK AROUND




Watch for falling limbs or tree tops (widow makers)

- Solid footing
- Eye on target
- Good follow-through

Overhead salvo aimed at base of flames

Fan-shaped arc aimed at base of flames

Grass fire




ONE FOOT IN THE BLACK


Cut roots on both sides of the handline so the fire won't surface later.

HANDLINE CONSTRUCTION




Berm
Trench and berm for undercut line
Designed to stop rolling burning fuel



INFORMATION SHEET #5

Procedures Handbook 4300

HANDLINE CONSTRUCTION



Turn all burning material which may potentially roll across the handline, lengthwise, parallel to the slope of the hill
