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## Conference Technique

# INFORMATION SHEET #2

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## Group Discussion Techniques

Divide the students into groups of 4-6 students each. Give the students a problem statement and have them develop a solution. After 10 minutes of discussion have the group spokesperson present their solution and describe the process by which the solution was developed.

### Problem Statement

Student X is a volunteer firefighter who is a problem learner in that he is receiving low scores on annual manipulative proficiency tests and also disrupts other volunteer firefighters who are trying to master the manipulative skills necessary to do well on the annual tests.
