One of the purposes for which state forests were acquired is to reforest cutover lands. State forests will be used to determine the economic feasibility of artificial reforestation, to demonstrate the production and economic possibilities of good forest practices, and to maintain forest cropland in a productive condition. Because state forests are used for demonstration purposes and because their poorly stocked timberlands are representative of a large portion of California's 750,000 acres of state and private timberlands, state forests should be used for experiments in reforestation.

Before reforestation projects are initiated in state forests, they must have approval of the region chief and director (see [Section 5060](#) of this handbook).
