

## **SALES POLICY**

**5041**

(May 1988)

The Director, with the approval of the Department of General Services, may make sales of forest products from state forests. The sale of timber and forest products is limited to raw materials only. Forest products must be sold in accordance with the following instructions and conform to the approved forest management plan.

## **EXPORTATION OF STATE FOREST TIMBER**

**5041.1**

(May 1988)

Timber from state forests will not be sold to any primary manufacturer or to any person who would resell to a primary manufacturer who makes use of such timber at any plant not located within the United States, unless the timber is sawn on four sides to dimensions not greater than four inches by twelve inches in accordance with PRC §4650.1.

Timber from state forests will not be substituted for timber exported from private timberlands in California in accordance with 14 CCR §1515-1521.

Purchasers of state forests should be informed of the domestic manufacturing requirements prior to the award of any timber sale. Such notification will be included in "Notice of Timber Sale," and specific provisions will be included in all sale agreements.

## **FOREST PRACTICE ACT**

**5041.2**

(May 1988)

The Z'berg-Nejedly Forest Practice Act of 1973 applies to state forest timber harvesting operations. Timber harvesting plans for state forest timber sales will be prepared by the forest manager and filed at the appropriate region office with the Director of Forestry and Fire Protection. All timber operators engaged in timber operations, as defined in PRC §4527, on state forest timber sales must have a valid timber operator's license. State forest timber sales will be inspected by forest practice officers for compliance with the Act and district forest practice rules. State forest personnel will cooperate fully with forest practice officers in conducting inspections and obtaining compliance with the act and rules.
