

CLASSES OF SALES

(May 1988)

Each sale of products from a state forest will be processed automatically as required for the particular class of sale it involves. The class is determined as follows:

- Class I sales are noncompetitive sales that do not exceed \$10,000 in value or are not in excess of 100,000 board feet.
- Class II sales were discontinued in April 1976.
- Class III sales consist of all competitive sealed-bid sales. Normally the value will be in excess of \$10,000 or the volume in excess of 1000,000 board feet ([see Section 5045](#)).
