

TIMBER SALE BOUNDARIES

Before cutting is begun in any state timber sale area, all sale boundary lines will be inspected carefully by a forest officer. In running lines between state land and that of another owner, it is desirable, when practical, to review such boundaries in company with the neighboring owner to avoid any misunderstanding that otherwise might develop in marking trees on or near the property line. As nearly as possible, the line trees should be divided on a value basis between the state and the other party concerned. When the boundary survey of a timber sale area is made, the boundary will be posted or marked at frequent intervals to ensure that the sale area is clearly delineated. A timber sale boundary sign was developed for this purpose. When the sale has been completed, all timber sale boundary signs will be removed.
