The historical records of a state forest normally are a part of the permanent file of each state forest. These include the following:

Past events which bear upon the history of the forest.

- Acquisition data.
- Inventories and appraisals.
- Timber management plans.
- Experiments and demonstrations.
- Timber sale records.
- Timber stand improvement records.
- Fire prevention and protection plan.
- Fire atlas--history and current records.
- Cost accounting.
- Insect and disease control data.
- Forest developments.
- Forest uses data.

Each region chief supervising the administration of a state forest will make provisions for keeping these records current, organized, and readily available. It is quite necessary, in view of PRC §4631, that the Director have readily available at all times such records as will indicate economic and silvicultural history and current plans, especially for those state forests making commercial sales of forest products.
