PEST CONTROL ADVICE TO LANDOWNERS

Pest control advice to landowners for "agricultural use" must be in writing and prepared by a licensed pest control advisor. The California Food and Agriculture Code defines "agricultural use" as the use of any pesticide or method or device for the control of plant or animal pests, or the use of any pesticide for the regulation of plant growth or defoliation of plants.

Pest control advisors can only give written pest control advice to landowners when they are registered in the county where the specific property requiring the advice is located.

RM-30 (Pest Control Recommendation-not available in e-format) is the form that will be used by the pest control advisor when providing pest control advice. The pest control advisor must retain this form for three years from the date that it is issued. The pest control advisor must notify the appropriate County Agricultural Commissioner of the location where the form is filed and available for review. The pest control advisor has sole custody of the form. It does not have to be submitted to the unit, region office or Sacramento.
