

DISTRICT TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEES (DTACs) 5420

(No. 3 June 1991)

DTACs are advisory to the Board of Forestry. The Board of Forestry, at its April 10, 1974 meeting (referenced in the minutes as Motion 74-4-1), adopted the "District Technical Advisory Committees' Rules of Order" to govern the DTACs in the selection of officers and the conduct of other committee business. The Board of Forestry appoints an employee of the department as secretary for each DTAC (PRC §4528). In practice, the employee has been a region chief, originally appointed individually and subsequently by title, as a vacancy occurs. Under the DTA Rules of Order, the board also appoints, individually, an alternate secretary to perform the duties of the secretary or to serve in the secretary's absence. The validity and effectiveness of committee actions depends on how the secretary carries out his/her role. He/she meets with and takes part in all deliberations of the committee but does not have the power of a vote except in the case of a tie vote.
