

TIMBER OPERATOR LICENSE

5430

(No. 3 June 1991)

PRC § 4571 requires any person* who engages in timber operations, or who contracts with others to conduct timber operations** on their behalf, to have in his/her possession a valid timber operator license issued by the Director. The valid license or a copy must be available for inspection at the site of active timber operations (14 CCR § 1029).

Exceptions to this requirement are permitted when:

- Any person engaging in timber operations is an employee whose sole compensation is wages.
- Operations are conducted upon timber or timberland under the control of a federal agency.
- A person is conducting operations exclusively for personal use of the forest products from his/her own property; that is, the products are not for sale or trade.
