

LICENSE ISSUANCE

5436

(No. 3 June 1991)

An application for a license or renewal license will be date stamped upon receipt and will be processed promptly by the Sacramento office, unless there are ground for denial.

A Timber Operator license (RM-61) or Limited Timber Operator License (RM-62) will be issued upon receipt of an appropriate, acceptable application. The original and one copy of the license will be sent to the licensee. The year for which the license is valid will be shown thereon. The duplicate and triplicate copies of the approved license application (RM-3) will be sent to the region office as notice that the license has been issued ([see Section 5433](#)).

Once issued, the license continues in effect and can be renewed annually until suspended or revoked (PRC § 4573, 4574, and 4576). The license (or a copy) must be available for inspection at the site of active timber operations (14 CCR § 1029).

An operator holding a valid license will be sent application forms (RM-3) by mail from the Sacramento office each November.

REPLACEMENT OF LICENSE

5436.1

(No. 3 June 1991)

A licensee may request that the Director replace a lost, destroyed, or mutilated license. The written request must name the applicant and provide the address and other information necessary to show that the person submitting the replacement request is the person to whom the license was issued originally. An exact duplicate of the original license will be sent at no charge.

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

5436.2

(No. 3 June 1991)

A timber operator must notify the Director within 15 days of any change of address. The notice must be in writing and directed to the Sacramento office (14 CCR § 1030).
