

CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP AND CANCELLATION OF PLAN 5465

(No. 3 June 1991)

Any report of change of ownership of land and/or timber or any request for cancellation of a plan as required under 14 CCR § 1042 and 1043 should be made to the region chief.

When a request for cancellation of a plan is received, the region chief shall do the following:

- Require that any necessary fieldwork and reports by CDF personnel be done to ensure that the cancellation is only applied to that portion of the plan applicable to lands not yet harvested.
- Ensure that suitable notice and documentation, including map delineation of the canceled area, are prepared and sent to each location where the THP was filed, to the submitter, to the RPF, and to the timber operator.
- Return a request for cancellation not signed by all parties, or their successors in interest, who submitted a plan.
