CDF is not primarily responsible for the administration and enforcement of all laws and regulations that apply to the cutting, transportation, and sale of Christmas trees. Many other agencies have some of these regulatory powers. However, in the eyes of the general public, the department and U.S. Forest Service are considered to be the primary regulatory agencies on this subject, and, as such, receive many requests for information on Christmas tree harvesting. Consequently, CDF personnel have the obligation to properly inform the public about the laws, regulations, and facts about Christmas trees. To aid in accurately informing the public, an information leaflet, "Regulations

Affecting Christmas Tree and Greenery Operations," has been prepared by the department's headquarters office and made available through region and unit headquarters offices for free distribution upon request.
