

DEPARTMENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES

CDF is responsible for the general administrative and technical operations of the survey. The department selects areas to be worked, lists priorities, approves budgets of the cooperators, and coordinates the functions of the cooperators. The department employs, or arranges for the employment of, necessary personnel for mapping, drafting, and clerical work. The department also consults with the staff of the U.S. Soil Conservation Service and of the University of California Departments of Forestry and Resource Management, Land, Air and Water Resources, and Agronomy and Range Science on technical matters.

CDF is responsible for reports of progress to the state Board of Forestry, other state agencies, and the Legislature. CDF is also responsible for the development of annual budget requests to the Legislature to continue the work. These duties are assigned to the Director's office.

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
