

**NOTICE OF STOCKING REQUIREMENTS**  
**(5000)**  
**(May 1988)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that each timberland owner or his/her agent, pursuant to provisions of Section 4587 of the Public Resources Code must, within five years after completion of timber operations on an area covered by a Timber Harvesting Plan, file with the Director of Forestry a Report of Stocking on said timberland.

The timber owner is not relieved of his obligation to restock said lands or his/her obligation to file the required Report of Stocking until such time as the Director issues a "Report of Satisfactory Completion of Stocking" for said lands under the provisions of Section 4588 of the Public Resources Code.

This notice is applicable to the area on which timber operations have been or are being conducted under Timber Harvesting Plan number \_\_\_\_\_ on that certain property in \_\_\_\_\_ County, known as the \_\_\_\_\_ property, currently owned by same, and further described as follows:

Said lands are subject to the stocking requirements of the Forest Practice Act, Sections 4561 through 4561.6 of the Public Resources Code, and the Forest Practice Rules for the \_\_\_\_\_ Forest District in Sections \_\_\_\_\_ through \_\_\_\_\_, Title 14, California Code of Regulations. Said operations must also comply with all other applicable provisions of the Act and Forest Practice Rules. If said stocking requirements are not met at the end of five (5) years after completion of the timber operations, the Director of Forestry may, pursuant to the provisions of the Forest Practice Act, Sections 4608 through 4611 of the Public Resources Code, notify the timber operator, and owners of the timber and timberland of their duty to carry out such site preparation and reforestation measures as necessary to meet stocking requirements. If such reforestation measures are not carried out by said persons, the Director may do the work or contract to have it done, and bill said persons for the costs pursuant to the provisions of Sections 4609 and 4610 of the Public Resources Code. If not paid, said costs shall become a lien upon the property as provided by law.
