JOINT YOUTH CONSERVATION CAMP OPERATIONS
(May 2003)

Responsibility

This handbook is issued by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CDF) and the California Department of Youth Authority (CYA) as the primary source of instructions and guidance for CDF and CYA employees in the Youth Conservation Camp Program. Statutory law and formal contracts of agreement are superior legal controls. It is the clear responsibility of the directors to interpret laws, regulations and agreements and prepare and issue instructions which conform with such authorities and operational conditions of both departments.

The instructions contained in this manual apply to all employees assigned to work in the Conservation Camp Program and also to those employees who may be temporarily or indirectly associated with the camp program. The conservation camps are administered jointly by CDF and CYA. This handbook is recognized by both agencies as part of camp policy and operating procedures. It is the responsibility of both agency administrators at the camp level to integrate the two agencies' regulations to provide a smooth camp operation, recognizing that any individual action by one agency may directly affect the other.

Personnel assigned to or associated with youth conservation camps will be familiar with and abide by these instructions and all other orders, laws, and rules and regulations issued, distributed, or posted for the instruction or guidance of all camp personnel.
