Each conservation camp has a designated name jointly selected and approved by CDF and CYA.

A comprehensive, dual-agency roster has been developed which is amended and re-published periodically. This roster contains the following information for each conservation camp and training facility:

- Name
- Three-letter designator
- Index number
- Telephone and FAX numbers for each agency
- Responsible individual for each agency
- Addresses of each agency
- Delivery address
- Design population
- Number of budgeted crews
- Location of the camp including
 - Narrative description
 - Legal description
 - Latitude and longitude
- Date the camp was opened.
- Command structure for each agency (located at the end). These pages contain the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of those individuals who coordinate the Conservation Camp Program at the institution, region, and headquarters levels.

As information changes relative to any of the camps, that information should be forwarded to the respective agency's Sacramento Camp Office for processing into the next revision.
