The following sections, 6291, 6292 and 6293, and their respective subsections, describe the process of reporting emergency incident time and other time where reimbursements will be made. In all cases, the completed forms constitute legal documents, by which overtime is paid and departmental expenses are reimbursed. Consequently, utmost care in the preparation, distribution, and retention of these documents is necessary.

CYA is not reimbursed by CDF for costs incurred on non-fire emergencies unless the costs were incurred at the request of CDF. Time and cost documentation for non-fire emergency operations should be recorded in a similar fashion as described below to accommodate other cost recovery procedures such as FEMA claims and Budget Deficiency Requests.
