

# **BASIC COMPLEMENT OF FIRE TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT**

## **Responsibility**

### **Division Chief**

Each conservation camp crew vehicle will be equipped with at least the following items at all times during fire season:

1. Cutting tools, such as axe, brush hook, Pulaski, etc. (28)
2. Chain saw, as available (2).
3. Scraping tools (10).
4. Handie-Talkie (2).
5. Canteens, 4 quart (20).
6. Fire extinguisher (2).
7. Shovel L.H., RP (11).
8. Cutter, bolt (1).
9. Flashlight, headlamp (20) with batteries.
10. Safety line, 100 feet by one-half inch, Nylon (1).
11. Flashlight, hand-held (1).
12. Sledgehammer, #8, (2).
13. Falling Wedges, (2).

## OTHER SPECIAL EQUIPMENT

### Responsibility

#### **Camp Superintendent Division Chief**

For each ward on the crew vehicle, the following special equipment will be carried:

1. Sleeping bag (1).
2. Ration bag (1).
3. Ration (2).
4. Fire shelter.
5. Nomex clothing.
6. Safety helmet.
7. Goggles.
8. Shroud.
9. Fire gloves.

Optional items—

1. Ground cloth (1).
2. Belt canteen (2).
3. Web belt (1).

## CREW PERSONAL EQUIPMENT AND TRAVEL KITS

### Responsibility

#### **Division Chief Camp Superintendent**

Each ward will be issued a fire bag (supplied by CYA) in which the following listed clothing items (supplied by CYA) shall be maintained in a clean and orderly manner for use by the ward when on extended emergency assignment. No items of personal apparel other than the following items issued by the state will be worn when away from "home" conservation camp:

1. Bag, personal (1)
2. Undergarments, pants and shirts (3 sets)
3. Brassieres (women) (3)
4. Shirts (3)
5. Pants (3 pr)
6. Socks (4 pr)
7. Toilet items
8. Handkerchiefs (2)
9. Towels (2)
10. Belts (1)
