Laws, rules, and regulations are developed at different levels of control to provide for the supervision and custody of DJJ offenders. Laws of the state are supreme. Regulations are generally written to permit administrative officers and camp supervisory personnel to jointly develop rules for local problems and conditions.

No law, regulations, or rule is by intention unnecessary or in conflict with another. If any appears to be, the employee should promptly ask for an interpretation from his/her supervisor.
