### **Responsibility**

#### **Camp Commander**

The operation of offender canteens, handicraft programs, library, mail, visiting, volunteers, manuscripts, legal documents, and personal property in each conservation camp will be in accordance with the CDCR Director's Rules contained in California Code of Regulations, Title15, (I & C Manual).

## **CLOTHING**

**6439.1**

### **Responsibility**

#### **Camp Commander**

A clothing allotment has been established to properly clothe each offender in the camp program. Offender clothing will be, for the most part, restricted to the items listed in the CDCR DOM Section 51130.22; Section 54090. Only authorized state issued clothing and safety gear will be permitted on the CCV/ECT.

Special, or safety, clothing required for offender crews will be retained on the Crew Carrying Vehicles/Emergency Crew Transports for emergencies.

## **OFFENDER HANDICRAFT PROGRAM**

### **Responsibility**

#### **Camp Commander**

#### **Superintendent**

The Camp Commander/Superintendent may, after consultation with the Division Chief, establish an offender handicraft program. If established, or existing, the program will be detailed in an Operational Guideline. (See Handbook [Sections 6411-6414](#)), DOM Sections 51130.25.5; 53080 through 53080.20.6

In addition to items required for the Operational Guideline, as detailed in [Section 6414](#), the Camp Commander/Superintendent will include procedures that ensure compliance with other conservation camp activity standards, such as CDCR regulations, knife and tool control, and the Injury and the Illness Prevention Plan.
