

## **FIRE CREW PERFORMANCE EVALUATION**

### **Responsibility**

#### **Division Chief**

In order to ensure the fire readiness of the fire crew resources, each camp will conduct an annual Fire Crew Performance evaluation of each fire crew using Exhibit 6468, [Fire Crew Performance Criteria CAL FIRE Type I and Type II Fire Crews](#), as the performance standard. The evaluation should take place prior to fire season with re-evaluations throughout the year as crew membership changes.

Preparation for the evaluation should stimulate local fire crews and engine companies to drill together on progressive hoselays and line construction. This interface can have a positive effect on attitudes toward teamwork on fires. A centralized fire resource performance evaluation exercise may be utilized, or local evaluations must be conducted. Individual fire crew and engine company drills in preparation for the evaluation are encouraged.
