DISPATCHING CREWS AND PERSONNEL

When calls dispatching offender crews from camp or work projects to an emergency incident are received, the following information must be shared immediately with the CDCR camp commander or Superintendent, or the CDCR person in charge, to permit response preparation and determination of custodial coverage

1. Time of notification
2. Order and request number
3. Immediate need or planned need and time of departure required
4. Area of incident, or destination county and nearest community
5. Type of incident, and any other pertinent information.

The home camp staff, both CDCR and CAL FIRE, will be advised of crew location changes through appropriate channels.

MOBILE KITCHEN UNITS (MKU'S)

Identified conservation camps will be assigned Mobile Kitchen Units (MKU) for incident support. Camps with an MKU assigned shall provide training to offenders and staff to ensure effective operation of the MKU. To ensure that qualified cooks and staff exist during periods of peak draw down, each camp with an MKU may train additional staff and offenders at an adjoining camp in MKU operations.
