

TRANSMISSION REPAIR

6823

(January 1988)

An inventory of rebuilt automatic truck transmissions is left at DEF for field use. The transmissions are mounted on shipping cradles for easy handling by either CDF or commercial carriers.

To receive a replacement transmission, the responsible FEM will call DEF directly and provide the following information for shipment:

- Assigned station
- Administrative unit
- District
- Equipment maintenance manager's name
- "X" number
- License number
- Vehicle type
- Vehicle model
- Vehicle manufacturer
- Brief description of transmission problem

When the rebuilt transmission is received in the field, return the disabled transmission to DEF for rebuilding as soon as possible. Transmissions must be shipped in a CDF shipping cradle or a similar protective device. Plug all openings to prevent oil spillage. (Ref: [Fix-N-Fax, No. 5](#), Aug. 19, 1981.)

Should the particular item be out of stock, the facility manager will give either an availability date or a date on which the disabled transmission can be overhauled.
