SAFETY DEVICES FOR DUMP TRUCKS AND TILT BEDS **6859.1**
(No. 1 June 1989)

CAC Title 8, §1595, Construction Safety Orders, requires all trucks with dump bodies or beds to be equipped with a permanently attached, positive means of support to prevent accidental lowering of the body.

SEATBELTS **6859.2**
(No. 1 June 1989)

Seatbelts will be installed at all driver and passenger seats before the vehicle is operated. (See [Section 6784](#) of this handbook.)

FRESH AIR HELMETS **6859.3**
(No. 1 June 1989)

All Heavy Fire Equipment Operators (HFEOs) will wear helmets equipped to provide filtered air while operating CDF bulldozers during suppression activities and during other activities where the air is contaminated with dust or smoke.

CDF HFEOs will take their helmets with them to any assignments where they could be assigned to operate bulldozers.
