

FEDERAL EXCESS VEHICLE ACQUISITION/DISPOSAL

The state and the U.S. Forest Service (USFS) participate in the Federal Excess Property Program (FEPP) through which CDF and Rural Community Fire Protection organizations (RCFP) obtain excess property vehicles. These vehicles remain the property of the USFS but must be included in CDF's inventory and periodically be accounted for.

The acquisition and disposal of all excess property vehicles is handled by the USFS San Francisco office. All documents go to the USFS through the manager of the FEPP Property Section in Sacramento. Federal excess vehicles are to be used primarily for fire protection purposes and may not be rented or loaned to other agencies. All vehicle transactions must be pre-approved prior to screening by MEM and DGS. Actual acquisition and disposal is under the direction of FEPP.
