Reflective Tape on Equipment Trailers

This Fix-N-Fax authorizes the installation of “conspicuity” reflective tape on all tilt-bed trailers, detachable gooseneck trailers, and semi-trailers.

It is understood that it is impossible to place every element of CDF’s vehicle markings in precisely the same location when dealing with the wide variety, make, model and age of equipment involved. When retrofitting “conspicuity” tape, other elements of the Department’s existing markings shall not be altered.


Specification: 2” wide, alternating red and white, conspicuity reflective trailer tape, meeting federal regulations. Continuous or non-continuous tape can be used, depending on available vertical surface.

NOTE: This tape should not be confused with the white reflective material used on fire engines, and transport cabs.


Questions and recommendations on retrofitting, etc. should be directed to your local fleet manager.
