

ANNUAL SAFETY AND OPERATIONAL TRAINING REQUIREMENTS (7700)

(No. 21 March 1999)

The following subjects will be presented to rental equipment operators each year prior to fire season during an eight (8) hour safety and operational procedure training program. These subject areas will be taught in accordance with the lesson plans included in CAL FIRE Fire Protection Training Handbook 4300. Minimum instructional time frames are as follows:
