PURPOSE

8004.1

All CAL FIRE programs are supported by a statewide telecommunications system. To ensure continued efficient operation of this system, an improvement process exists to eliminate system deficiencies, provide modern replacement equipment, and implement all changes necessary to adapt the CAL FIRE communications system to changing responsibilities.

CAL FIRE’s Telecommunications system planning is a complex process involving all levels of management including:

- Telecommunications field staff
- OCC Chiefs
- Telecommunications Systems Manager
- Staff Chief of Operations (Fire Protection)
- Public Safety Communications staff
- CAPCOM Group (CAPCOM projects only)
- Budget Office (If warranted)
- Personnel (If warranted)
- Training

The Communications Planning Advisory Group (COMPLAG) was dissolved. All responsibilities previously held by COMPLAG will be managed by the members in the aforementioned list with the Telecommunications Systems Manager serving as the organizer. Ultimately the Staff Chief of Operations – Fire Protection, after considering recommendations by the OCC Chiefs through the telecommunications group, may authorize changes to standing systems.
