A unit facing compaction problems with the fourBdigit numbering system can use the alternate radio identification plan found in {[Section 8014.2.1](#)} ,for county- or district B owned resources to meet local needs and remain consistent with the CDF radio identification plan as outlined in this chapter. This plan will be submitted to Sacramento through channels after approval by region. Schedule "B" resources will retain their radio identifiers at all times, even though they may be used as part of a local government contract.

Radio call signs for other equipment can be found in the ICS 420-1 Field Operations Guide. Each resource is identified with a radio call sign, along with other resource information, which should be used for all radio traffic.
