

COMMUNICATIONS WITH CONTRACT COUNTIES

It is essential that CDF maintain reliable and operationally efficient radio and microwave communications with contract counties such as Marin and Ventura. The formal operating agreements between ourselves and the contract counties must be explicit in their authority/permission for frequency sharing and should be reviewed and updated as needed.

It is permissible for contract-county ECCs to be given control of appropriate Airguard remote transceivers on a cost-sharing basis in order for them to communicate with CDF and federal aircraft operating within their jurisdiction.

CDF resources of all types, including overhead, fire crews and equipment, are frequently dispatched to contract counties to assist with major incidents. Mobile Communications Centers (MCCs), portable mobile relays and/or emergency incident base radios may be moved up as necessary to establish or augment communications using CDF frequencies.

Mobile relays and control stations may be engineered and installed permanently, when justified. All such projects must be requested through normal channels using Form COM-207 (see Chapter 8060) [{see section 8060}](#), and must be approved by the Deputy Director for Fire Protection.
