The CDF Telecommunications Plan is published as a separate document. It contains detailed information about CDF's telecommunications planning and budgeting strategies. It contains detailed schedules for equipment replacement, major equipment purchases and major projects with projected timetables. Every TCO should have a copy.

The Plan is developed based upon region and statewide priorities and is used primarily by the Senior TCO and Deputy Chief, Command and Control Systems, in planning, administering, maintaining and implementing CDF's telecommunications programs and networks. It is also a source document for various budgetary activities, including presentations to CDF managers and members of the legislature. A multi-year plan [{see Exhibit}](#); reflecting CDF's telecommunications needs over the next ten years is displayed in Exhibit 8080.1.

At least once per year, the Plan will require updating efforts and assistance from all field TCOs to keep it accurate and timely. Requests for current information about system hardware, major projects anticipated, etc. will be routed through channels from HQ to each region and unit TCO. Timely and accurate responses to such requests will ultimately benefit all concerned.
