

PROCEDURE NO. 015: United States Military Forces

(July 2010)

Federal military resources may be available for use. Federal military resources are accessed through the National Interagency Coordination Center (NICC). In order to assess availability or to access these resources contact to NICC should be made through the appropriate Region OCC. NICC will advise if resources are available. Due to the reflex time to activate this type of resource, consider future use and anticipated drawdown levels. Use of federal military resources requires approval of the Sacramento Duty Chief, but orders are processed at the region level to NICC.

Currently the San Diego Unit has agreements for military (rotary wing) assets that may be hired locally.

REGION OCC

1. Obtain federal military resource availability from NICC.
2. Advise Sacramento CC and Region Duty Chief of resource availability.
3. Through the Region Duty Chief, obtain Sacramento Duty Chief approval for the use of agreed-upon federal military resources.
4. Advise and coordinate with Unit ECC on needs based on Sacramento approval and appropriate resources available.
5. Create a CA-CSR or CA-CNR preposition number and generate the requests for the Military Forces.
6. Place federal military requests to NICC.

ECC

1. Enter request(s) for appropriate federal military resources in the resource ordering system of record.
2. Enter request for (1) Military Liaison Officer (MILO) in the resource ordering system of record.
3. Place requests to Region OCC.

REGION OCC

1. Receive request(s).
2. Reassign resources from the preposition.

3. Place MILO request to appropriate CC.

ECC

1. Upon notification that the federal military resources will be excess, consult with Region OCC regarding release or reassignment.
