Resource Ordering – CAL FIRE Aerial Supervision Module (ASM)

Aerial Supervision Module (ASM) is comprised of an aircraft staffed with two personnel, a lead plane qualified pilot and an Air Tactical Supervisor (ATSC). Both personnel have specialized training to perform both Lead Plane and Air Tactical Group Supervisor (ATGS) functions within a single aircraft. CAL FIRE has the ability to staff an ASM(s) as needed.

Responsibilities & Actions:

Any CC

1. Receives request for an ASM from either the Incident Commander or the Air Tactical Group Supervisor assigned to the incident.
2. Generate a request for an ASM in the Resource Ordering System of Record.
3. Place the request to the Region OCC using normal aircraft ordering procedures (see HB8100p320).

Region OCC

1. Receive a request for a CAL FIRE ASM.
2. If not staffed, contact the TAO Duty officer to determine availability.
3. Fill or place the request with to the Unit CC, other Region OCC or Sac CC in the Resource Ordering System of Record.

Sac CC

1. Receive request for ASM in the Resource Ordering System of Record and via the State Intercom.
2. Contact TAO Duty Officer to obtain fill information.
3. Notify the ASM personnel and provide them with the dispatch information using the [FC-106 Form](#).
4. Fill the request(s) in Resource Ordering System of Record.
5. Notify the Regions with the fill information.

6. Notify the Regions via the state intercom of availability and status changes as advised by TAO.

Region OCC

1. Notify the Unit CC with the fill information.
