

## **8100 PROCEDURE 606**

### **CAL FIRE Resource Activation “State of War Emergency”**

(March 2010)

When a “State of War” (Government Code Section 8558) exists or is declared against the United States, the “California Emergency Services Act” which contains the following sections listed below shall be adhered to:

- California Disaster Assistance Act
- Emergency Compacts
  - Interstate Civil Defense and Disaster Compact (1951)
  - Emergency Management Assistance Compact (2005)
- California Disaster and Civil Defense Master Mutual Aid Agreement

### **Responsibilities and Action**

#### **Any CC**

1. Utilize the CALFIRE Duty Chief and Duty Officer’s chain-of-command to engage and coordinate with Cal EMA at the levels indicated below. If deemed necessary CAL FIRE will dispatch an agency representative(s).
  - State Operations Center (SOC)
    - Cal EMA Headquarters – Mather
  - Regional Emergency Operations Center (REOC)
    - Inland - Sacramento
    - Coastal - Oakland
    - Southern – Los Alamitos
  - Operational Area or Local Emergency Operation Center (EOC)
2. For Resource Ordering, utilize [HB 8100p601 - Requests for CAL FIRE Resources to a Non-Fire or Non-Law Enforcement Incident from the California Emergency Management Agency](#) for non-fire emergencies.
3. For Resource Ordering, utilize 8100 Handbook Resource Ordering Procedures for wildland fire emergencies.
4. For operational security level considerations or modifications, utilize [HB 8100p900 - CAL FIRE Security Operation Levels](#).

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
