Burn Permit Suspension Proclamation and Termination

Burning under permit by any person on public or private lands, except within incorporated cities, may be suspended, restricted, or otherwise prohibited by proclamation. Any of the following public officers may issue a proclamation, which shall be applicable within their respective jurisdictions (PRC 4423.1):

- A. CAL FIRE Director or designee.
- B. Any County Fire Warden with the approval of the CAL FIRE Director.
- C. Federal officers directing activities within California representing the Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service and US Forest Service.

Burn Permit Suspension Proclamation and Termination notification requirements are the same.

Responsibilities and Action

ECC

1. Receive action, transmit to Region OCC.
2. If action is made by another level, record information and notify Unit Duty Chief.
3. Notify Unit Chief Officers, Unit CAL FIRE Facilities, Fire Districts and Cooperators.
4. Notify local Air Quality Management Authority. See Link for complete listing.

5. Notify local news media according to local policy.

Region OCC

1. If action is received from a Unit or Contract County, notify the Region Duty Chief and forward the declaration to the Sacramento CC.
2. If action is made by another level (region-wide or statewide), record information and notify Region Duty Chief. If region or statewide action, forward the information to the Units, Contract Counties, Region Cooperators, and Sacramento CC as appropriate.

Sacramento CC

1. Record information, notify Duty Chief.
2. Forward information to CAL FIRE staff and Cooperators as per Sacramento CC procedure.
