

## **EMERGENCY COMMAND CENTER REVIEWS**

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Emergency Command Centers (ECC) are the backbone for emergency dispatching of CAL FIRE and Cooperating Agencies, Unit Telecommunications, Command and Control, and the infrastructure of essential programs.

The review process has been established to ensure CAL FIRE ECCs are operating in a manner consistent with State and Department laws, rules, and regulations. The review process also verifies and validates the operational readiness of each of the Department's Emergency Command Centers.

The review process consists of an ECC Review Team which conducts annual reviews of the Department's Unit, Region, and Sacramento Command Centers. The findings are discussed with each Unit ECC Chief and compiled in a report, which is forwarded to the respective Unit and Region Chief.

The review process is intended to evaluate each of the Department's Command Centers once every three years.

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
